Hazard Trees: This video explores how firefighters can increase their hazard tree awareness and mitigation actions.

Summary:

1. Identify the hazard
2. Communicate the hazard to your immediate supervisor and those around you
3. Mitigate the hazard
 - Avoiding it (reroute the fire line)
 - Eliminating the tree (if you can safely)

Takeaways:

1. When conducting a prescribed burn, always stay within the perimeters of the burn plan (ex- temps., RH, winds, etc.)
2. Make sure to not only check the area being burned, but also be aware of the immediate area around the prescribed burn site (fuel type, especially make note of heavy fuels or extremely light/flashy fuels; terrain, etc.)
